Doctoral students and postdocs of all branches of humanities are warmly invited to present projects from their own field of research. The participants will have the opportunity to present specific aspects or current challenges within their own area of interest by reading a paper (25 min.). Afterwards there will be sufficient time for discussion (20 min.).

The aim of the conference is to provide doctoral students and postdocs with a forum for interdisciplinary communication and networking. Participants are not required to present finished projects but can share work in progress as well as challenges in their doctoral project and receive feedback from other doctoral students of the humanities.

In addition, we warmly welcome participants who want to make new acquaintances and exchange ideas with other doctoral students, but do not wish to give a talk of their own.
